



2019 BOAT OF THE YEAR NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority is the Narragansett Bay Yachting Association

1. RULES

- 1.1. Each race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. Each event is governed by *rules* published in each event's Notice of Race.
- 1.3. 2019 PHRF-NB ratings and rules apply to handicap classes.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1. NBYA membership is required to be included as part of the GMT BOTY Series, which is required prior to racing, no retroactive scoring is permitted. Membership is \$ 40.00 and is available at www.nbya.org/shop
- 2.2. Registration in the series is REQUIRED prior to racing and being scored. Registration is available at www.nbya.org/shop
- 2.3. There are no additional fee's for entry into the series beyond the event fee's as required by the event NOR's.

4. Scoring

- 4.1. Each event/regatta will be considered one score regardless of how many races are sailed. In the event of a tie, the ties are broken as determined by the race organizer.
- 4.2. Scores will be recorded using the Cox Sprague scoring system.
- 4.3. For the series, the final score will be equal to the total points earned in each regatta divided by the sum of the maximum possible points for each regatta.
- 4.4. A boat must race in at least five events/regattas to qualify for the award.
- 4.5. A boat that races in seven or more qualifying regattas may drop the results of one regatta.
- 4.6. A boat may designate IN ADVANCE a single event it wishes to EXCLUDE from the series scoring. This must be requested in writing and received and acknowledged by NBYA no later than 24 hours before the event.

5. Awards

- 5.1. Awards will be presented to the first place boat in both Spinnaker and Non-spinnaker classes

5.2. The winning boat's name will be engraved on the permanent GMT Composites Boat Of The Year Trophy and may be displayed at the winner's yacht club. The winner will also receive a keeper award. The prize giving will be at NBYA's Awards Banquet.

6. LIABILITY and MEDIA

- 6.1. Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority, Host Club, Volunteers, Sponsor (s) will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Attention is also drawn to ISAF Offshore Special Regulation 1.02, "Responsibility of the Person in Charge", as well as the "waiver and release of liability" as stated on the entry form.
- 6.2. In participating in this regatta, a competitor automatically grants to NBYA, the Organizing Authority, the organizing committee, and sponsors of the regatta the right in perpetuity to make, use and show at their discretion any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the regatta, and of all his or her material related to the regatta, without compensation.
